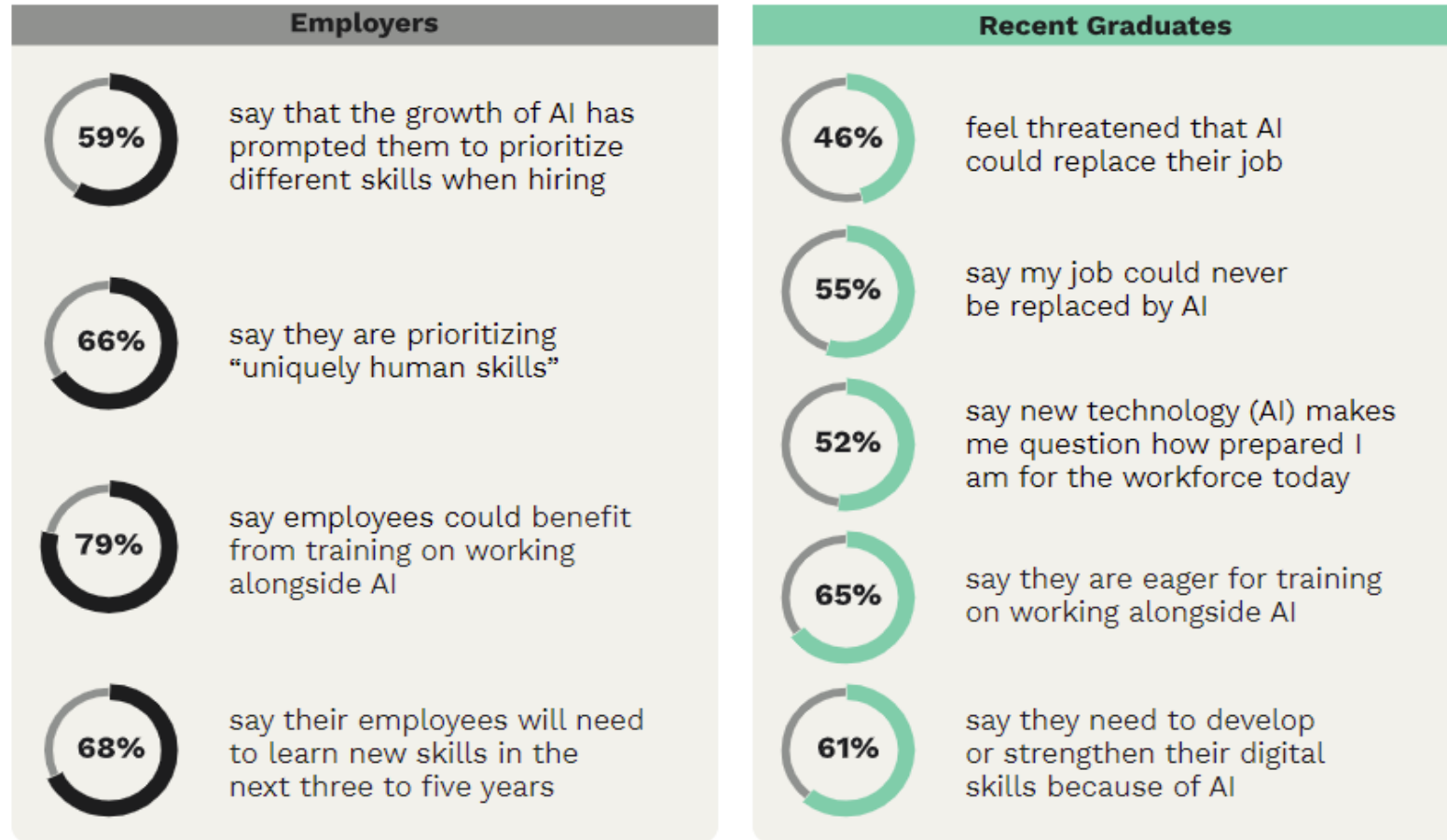
What Do Graduates (and Their Bosses) Say?

The oxidation number of nitrogen (N) in HNO_3 (nitric acid) is +5. In nitric acid (HNO_3), the hydrogen atom has an oxidation number of +1, and the oxygen atoms each have an oxidation number of -2. Since the overall charge of the nitric acid molecule is neutral, the oxidation number of nitrogen can be calculated:

Let x be the oxidation number of nitrogen.
