## Requirements

- Select an AI tool or platform you regularly use or are familiar with and explain how the AI tool is relevant to your studies.
- Provide examples of how the tool has supported you, your assignments, and your productivity in the classroom.
- Examples include ChatGPT, Canva AI, Grammarly, Quizlet, Claude AI, Gemini, Copilot, etc.

## Visual Display

- Prepare a visual display, such as a poster or digital presentation, that clearly explains the purpose and functionality of the AI platform and its applications in your academic life.
- Include visuals, screenshots, or examples illustrating how the tool supports your work.
- Be ready to provide a live demonstration of the AI tool in action (if possible) or walk attendees through a mock project highlighting its functionality.  
OR
- Provide a "before and after" example of how you worked on a task or assignment without AI and how AI improved it.
