### **Course Curriculum**

*THIS COURSE INTRODUCES STUDENTS TO RHETORICAL CONCEPTS AND AUDIENCE-CENTERED APPROACHES TO WRITING INCLUDING COMPOSING PROCESSES, LANGUAGE CONVENTIONS AND STYLE, AND CRITICAL ANALYSIS AND ENGAGEMENT WITH WRITTEN TEXTS AND OTHER FORMS OF COMMUNICATION.*

### **Goals**

*Students will achieve competency in writing for multiple audiences and purposes, researching and using sources correctly in MLA format, and implementing various rhetorical strategies by considering/employing the main rhetorical techniques.*
