APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process is complete when the following items are on file in the Fine & Performing Arts Division office, Building 100, the Mattie Kelly Arts Center, NWF State College, Niceville campus:

- 1. Completed, TYPED scholarship application form.**
- 2. Verification of applicant's cumulative GPA (Guidance Counselor's form).**
- 3. Letters of recommendation (2).**
One letter is required from an instructor and one letter from the guidance counselor or principal. "Letter of Recommendation" forms are attached to facilitate this process.
- 4. Photograph of applicant. (Preferably wallet sized)** Please attach to your scholarship application with a paperclip; do not use staples, tape, or glue. Print your name on the bottom back edge of the photo.
- 5. Schedule your audition.** Please email Caitlin TaraBori in the Fine and Performing Arts Division office at taraboric@nwfsc.edu to schedule your audition.

Failure to submit your paperwork by the dates listed below may result in not being considered for scholarship awards.

Application Deadline: Saturday, March 7, 2020. All application materials must be received in the Fine Arts Division office by this date.

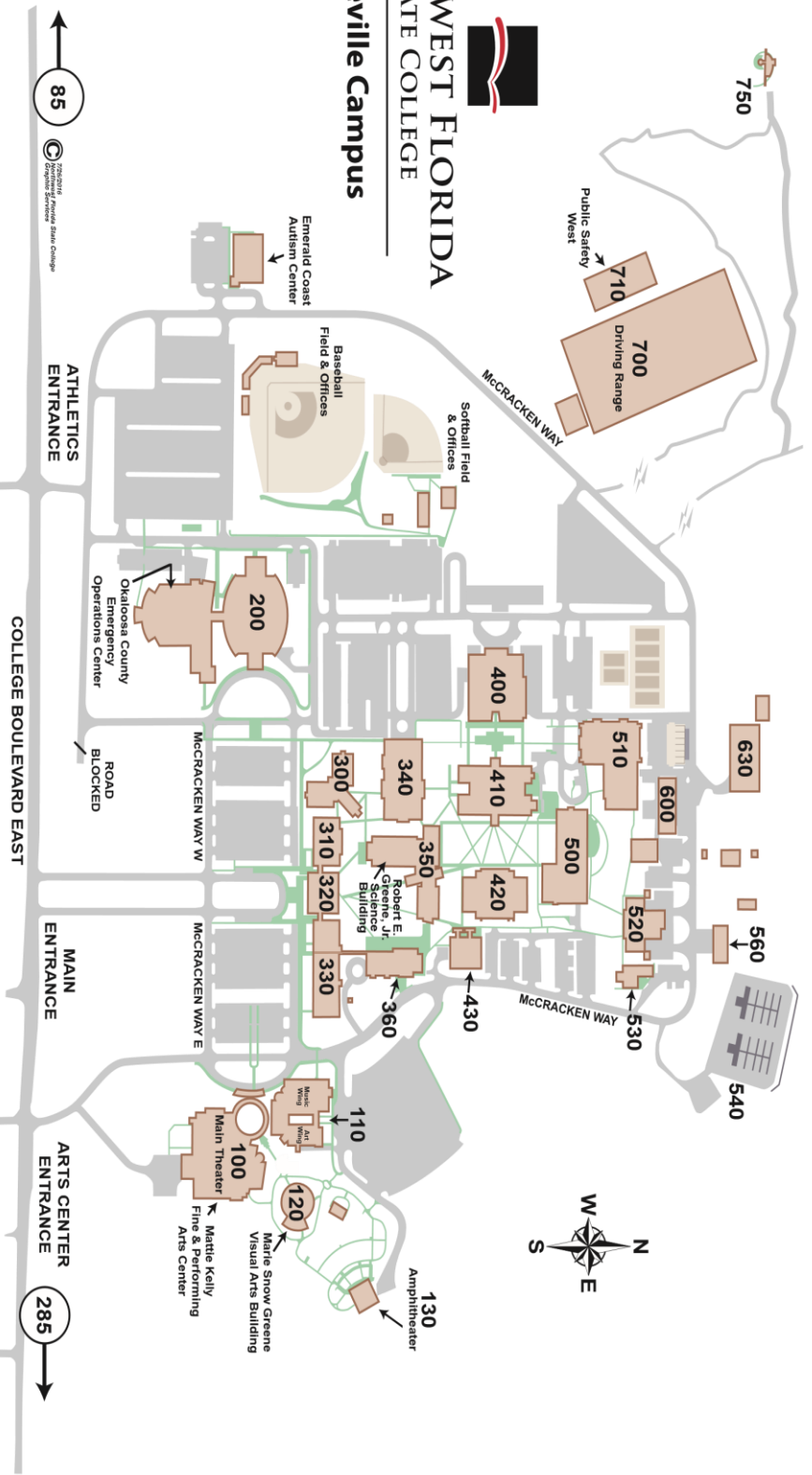
