APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process is complete when the following items are on file in the Humanities, Fine & Performing Arts Division office, Building 100, the Mattie Kelly Arts Center, NWF State College, Niceville campus:

- 1. Completed, TYPED scholarship application form AND portfolio.
- 2. Verification of applicant's cumulative GPA (Guidance Counselor's form).
- 3. Letters of recommendation (2).
 One letter is required from a high school or college art instructor and one letter from the guidance counselor or principal. "Letter of Recommendation" forms are attached to facilitate this process.
- **4. Photograph of applicant.** *(Preferably wallet sized)* Please attach to your scholarship application with a paperclip; do not use staples, tape, or glue. Print your name on the bottom back edge of the photo.

EVALUATION SCHEDULE

Failure to submit your paperwork by the dates listed below may result in not being considered for scholarship awards.

<u>Application & Portfolio Submission Deadline:</u> Monday, March 1, 2019. All application materials and portfolio must be received in the Fine Arts Division office on this date.

<u>Portfolio Review:</u> Your portfolio will be evaluated by the NWF State College Art Faculty by **Friday, March 22, 2019.**

Portfolio Retrieval: Portfolios must be picked up from the Fine Arts Office, 100-112 by Friday, March 29, 2019.

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
