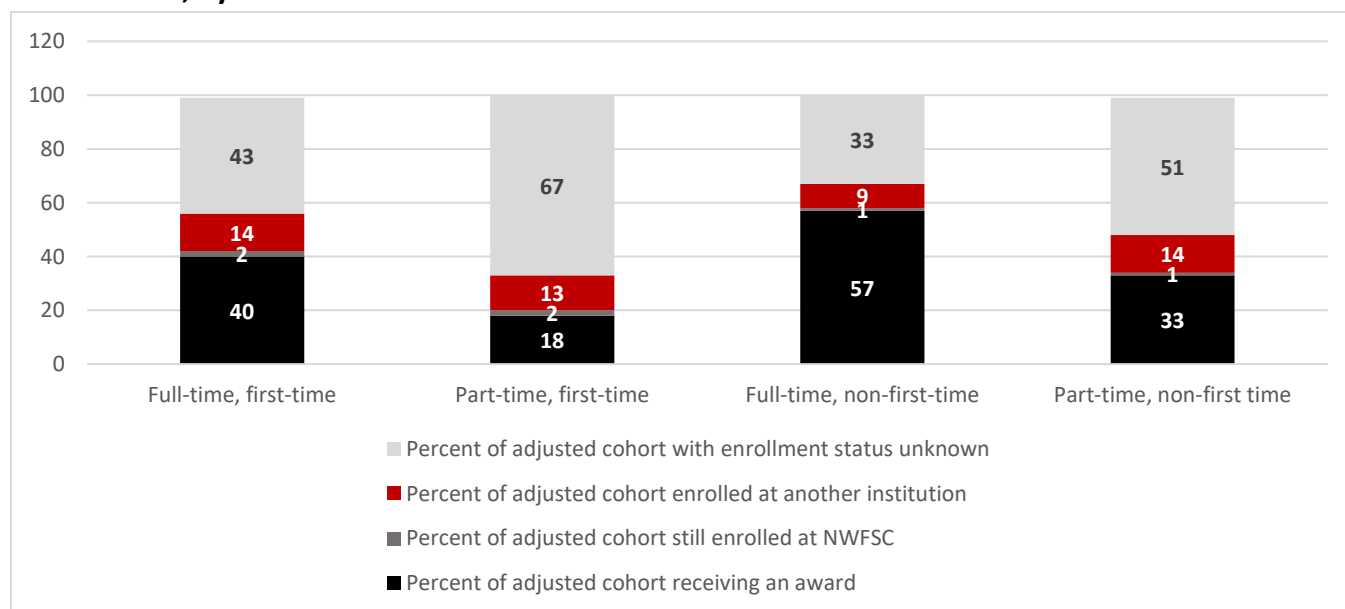
Graduation Rates:
