



**COURSE REQUIREMENTS FOR:
Motorcycle Safety Basic Rider Course at Northwest Florida State College**

This is a 2-day class held both Saturday and Sunday from 7:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. Please be there on time and ready to start class.

Participants will use bikes provided by NWF State College. Classes meet on the Niceville Campus, Building 710, Room 005, is adjacent to Driving Pad (700).

Requirements:

- Must have at least an automobile learner's license to take the BRC
- Motorcycles and helmets (full face and 3/4) are provided, or you may bring your own DOT approved helmet

Students must provide proper riding attire, to include:

- Eye Protection
- Full Finger Gloves
- Long Sleeved Shirt (Summer: white or light colored, dry fit or wicking material suggested)
- Long Pants (preferably denim jeans)
- Over Ankle Boots
- If it rains the day of your class, we will still ride. You may want to invest in an inexpensive two piece rain suit

Pre-requisites:

- You must be able to ride a two-wheeled bicycle for enrollment in the BRC.
- You are required to execute a "Release, Waiver and Indemnification" form. The form will be provided to you prior to participating in this course.
- Students under the age of 18 are required to have a parent or guardian sign the waiver form on the first day of class
