The RaiderRep Student Ambassador program at Northwest Florida State College is a leadership and scholarship opportunity for current students to promote and serve the mission of the college. RaiderReps serve as the official student hosts of Northwest Florida State College. They are positive, thoughtful, and enthusiastic student leaders who represent the college at special events, campus visits and tours, alumni and foundation activities, commencement, and recruitment events.

Benefits of Becoming a RaiderRep Student Ambassador:

- Scholarship of \$1000 per academic year (\$500 for the Fall semester/\$500 for the Spring semester).
- Leadership, stewardship and diversity learning development.
- Develop interpersonal communication and public-speaking skills.
- Gain an in-depth knowledge of Northwest Florida State College.
- Network with college and local community leaders.
- Meeting new students and make long lasting friendships.
- Resume building.

Eligibility Requirements

- Candidates must have applied to the college or are a current NWFSC degree-seeking student.
- Minimum 2.5 grade point average.
- Enroll in at least 6 credit hours per semester.

RaiderRep Student Ambassador Requirements

- Recipients must complete 15 hours of RaiderRep Ambassador functions each semester. Functions include:
 - Individual and/or group tours with prospective students.
 - New employee campus tours.
 - Attendance and/or hosting duties at campus and/or community events.
- Recipients must assist at Preview Day in the Fall and Commencement in May.
- Recipients must attend mandatory bi-monthly meetings.
- Recipients will serve as a RaiderRep Student Ambassador for at least 1 academic year beginning in the Fall semester running through the Spring semester.

Application Requirements

1. Completed online scholarship application form.
2. Completion of all NWF Admission requirements as a degree-seeking student.
3. Submit 2 letters of recommendation (one must be from a teacher or professor).
4. Meet the Selection Committee for an interview if selected as a finalist.
