1. COMPLETE THE NWFSC APPLICATION FOR ADMISSIONS

- Application deadlines:

- Fall: April 1
 - Spring: October 1
 - Summer: February 1



2. COMPLETE THE SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION FORM

3. PROVIDE PROOF OF HIGH SCHOOL OR SECONDARY SCHOOL COMPLETION

- Transcripts must be evaluated by a NACES – accredited credential evaluator for translation and evaluation.

- **Secondary School Transcript:**

- Must be evaluated to show United States high school equivalency

- **College and University Transcripts:**

- May be evaluated for individual course credit.

- Request the evaluation be mailed directly to:

4. PROVIDE PROOF OF ENGLISH PROFICIENCY

- Official TOEFL scores are required.

- Minimum score of 61 on the Internet-Based Test (IBT) for admission.

- Students who have evidence of English proficiency in lieu of a passing TOEFL may submit an [English Proficiency Exam Exemption Request](#) form*.



5. PROOF OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT

- Submit the [Affidavit of Support for International Students](#) form* with supporting documentation.
